We suggest bringing your dog's favorite blanket, rug or toy that will help him/her feel more comfortable and less anxious. Most dogs have fewer digestive issues when boarding if they are fed their normal food. **All dog food must be contained in sealable plastic or metal, such as a Tupperware container or cookie tin. No bags of dog food, opened or closed, will be accepted.**

Should you wish us to provide your dog with our own high-quality, grain-free chicken and rice kibble, there will be an additional \$3/day charge. We also offer a natural probiotic and digestive enzyme supplement to help your dog's tummy stay calm, balanced and problem free during their visit. Please let us know if you wish to use this service for an additional \$1/day, available whether we are feeding your food or ours.

Bifrost Farms agrees to exercise due and reasonable care and to keep our kennel premises sanitary and properly enclosed. All dogs are boarded, trained, or otherwise handled or cared for by us without liability on our part of loss or damage from disease, death, running away, theft, fire, injury to persons, other dogs, or property by said dog, or other unavoidable causes, due diligence and care having been exercised.

If the state of your dog's health demands immediate quick action, we shall have the right to pursue veterinary care and administer medicine provided by the veterinarian. Bifrost Farms has the right to make this judgment call and the owner agrees to pay for all veterinary expenses, being reasonable in amount (see below). If your dog is found to have fleas or ticks, he/she will be bathed with a medicated flea shampoo to prevent infesting others in the kennel at the owner's expense of \$30. No pet will be accepted without proof of current rabies vaccination.

You, the owner, understand that Bifrost Farms only requires a current rabies vaccination for all boarding dogs, and not all dogs will have been vaccinated with the Bordatella (Kennel Cough) vaccine. This is the dog equivalent of the common cold and even though your dog may have been vaccinated, the vaccine does not fully protect your pet from all possible strains of upper-respiratory disease. The incubation period can be anywhere from 3-10 days in which the dog shows no signs of illness, but is still contagious. You, the owner, understand that canine cough is an airborne virus that can be present anywhere (parks, vet's office, sidewalks), and that we can no more prevent the possibility of your dog contracting canine cough than your local school can prevent children from passing on a cold or the flu.

Owners of any dogs displaying human aggression will be asked to have the dog picked up immediately from our facility. The staff is trained to deal with all types of dogs, but it is for the safety of all concerned that we not keep truly aggressive dogs with the will and tendency to attack on our grounds.

We require a 24-hr notice of cancellation for all reservations. Any reservation cancelled with less than 24-hr notice is subject to a \$25 cancellation fee due immediately. Pick-up after 6pm Mon-Sat and 4pm Sunday will incur a \$25 late fee.

Although our hours are 8-11am and 3-6pm Monday through Saturday and by appointment from noon to 4pm on Sunday, we do ask that you provide an estimated time of arrival for drop off or pick up. We are also a working farm and while we will be on the premises, may not necessarily be in the office should you come outside of the time you indicated. Bifrost Farms is closed for drop-off and pick-up on July 4th, Thanksgiving, Christmas and New Year's Day.
